

REQUIREMENTS, RESTRICTIONS & INSTRUCTION **FOR BIA OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT PERMIT**

1. Fill out the forms electronically (preferred) and "saveas" with new filename and return it via Email.
2. Hand fill application are acceptable but must be clear and legible.
3. A map that shows which BIA routes are to be used for the haul route, highlighted.
4. Size Restriction - Guide for Vehicle Weights and Dimensions:
 - a. "No vehicle using completed sections of the National Truck Network shall exceed a width of 102 inches (8'6"), exclusive of approved safety devices and tire bulge due to load."
 - b. And "No vehicle shall exceed a height of 13'6"
5. Hauls on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays are not allowed.
6. Axle Drawing Diagram.
 - a. REQUIRED for loads over 76,800 lbs.
 - b. NOT REQUIRED if the load is Under 76,800 lbs.
7. Loads over 76,800 lbs. will require our Structural Engineer's review & signature.
The Structural Engineer will check to ensure all the structures along the requested route are capable of withstanding the haul loads.
8. If the Structural Engineer does not concur with the proposed haul routes, the applicant may be asked to seek an alternate route which may delay the permit application process.
9. The application will then be reviewed, processed & the permit will be issued as soon as possible.

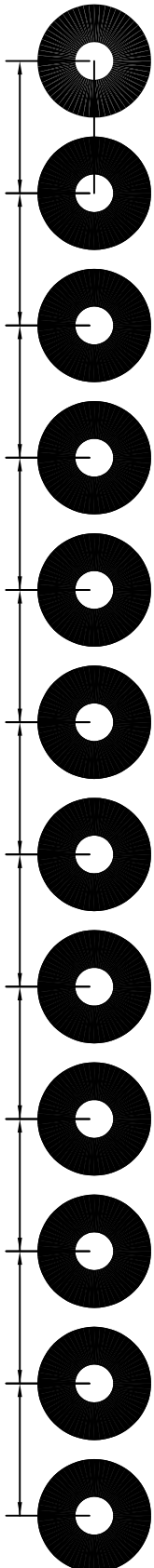

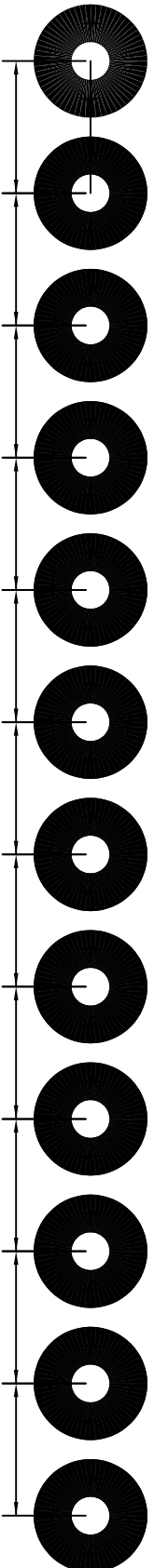

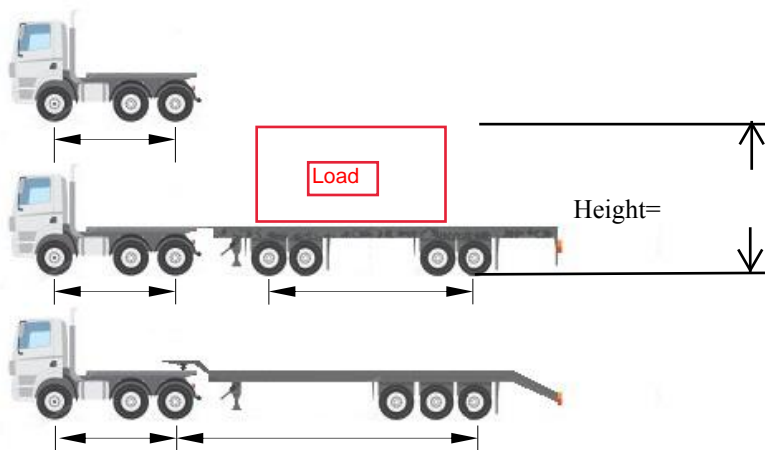
